

YULE BOCK, FROM FINLAND

Many are the places which try to own the Yule-Bock (Santa) institution, but we can prove that he is Finnish by birth, by using FINNISH, and the ROOT language, which is still spoken at the southern part of Finland.

When we started writing the old spoken languages, we made many errors, so much so that we lost much of our history, especially when translating the ROOT language into English, for example. There are certain vowels for which there are no proper letters in other languages, like Ä, Ö, Å, what mixes the whole thing, you cannot write history without them.

But to the Yule-Bock himself. The word "Yule" comes from the word HJUL which means a disc, the SUN, so the Yule Bock is actually a SUN BOCK, celebrated just after the winter solstice, when the sun starts getting up a little bit earlier. At Rome it was called a SATURNALIA feast. At near-east they called it a day of the "wrong king", as the Yule Bock was "ruling" just the one day, when gifts were given for children, and adults were supposed to pay their debts off, and settle their grievances.

There are three men in the Sun family, the Lord, (Ukko) with a full beard, the Bock (Pukki) with bock beard, (still seen at the Pharaohs of Egypt) and the King (Seppo) with moustaches. They were never shown without a mask. At the Sun feast, the day before, it was the Bock who came in the evening inside at our homes (still does) with a sack of gifts, next day was the real HOLY day, and at the next, the Boxing day, was the day for the Lord himself, he made the farewell visits.(boxing

means that the candidates for being breeders sat on a raised log, feet off the ground, facing each other and tried to get the opponent down with a bag filled with sand, after that the winners had other tests to pass)

But what were the gifts in the first place, originally it was the Bock himself (the God of fertility) for whom a NEKTAR was collected and given. (nectar, sperm, given out by thousands of men, but because it cannot be stored, it had to be drunk, and the drinker gave it off from himself for the next one) Then the Bock had to inseminate hundreds of young women, of the next lower caste, (the ros-ätt cast) and that that was his gift for the mankind. He really needed all that strength to be able to do his duty. (Wham) He also had to have twelve sons and seven daughters with his wife (the Swan, or Sámejtar) too, but that was easy. Anyway you can understand that he was a busy man who needed all the nectar available.

Recently a friend brought from India a Santa's mask, exactly like we have here in Finland (former Vinland) except that there are three leaves and three berries from the HOLLY tree at its temple! Now that goes back for about 4000 years, when the weather was a lot warmer here at the north, when those trees were growing here. People, the Arians, moved to India from here when the weather got too cold to live here. Those three leaves and berries mark the three men of the SUN family. The Lord himself had also a walking stick made out of the Holly wood too. At circuses Ukko had a bear's skin on, Bock had bock's skin, with horns and tail too, and

the King had the skin of a fox on him. Ukko smoked a straight pipe, same as Bock, the King smoked a curved pipe. They smoked hemp. The First Family's mark was a circle, propeller was for the second caste, and when those were put together, it was the mark for Hel. Western part of Uden-land (Vinland) was of the King and Queen (brother and sister) Hel in the center was that of Ukko's, and eastern part for the Bock. (where his underground rock-temple is supposed to be, not found yet)

Right in the center of present Helsinki (est. 1550) by the Aleksanterinkatu, there are three oldest blocks named after the three royal men, standing **Lion** for the Lord, **Tiger** for the King, and **Pan**-ther for the Bock.

The royal family had also ceremonial clothing, of which models we can still see today in the flags of Finland and Scandinavia, and Greece. The **Suometar, the Goddess of Fertility**, had white gown with blue belt, as are the colors of the flag of Finland, white background with blue cross. **The King, the God of Love**, had blue coat with golden yellow belt, as are the colors in the flag of Sweden, blue background with a golden yellow cross. **The Lord, the God of Heaven and Earth**, had red coat with white belt, as are the colors of the flag of Denmark, red background with white cross. (from the Danish court came most of the European royal families) **The Queen, the Goddess of Love** had blue gown with silvery white belt, which colors are now in the flag of Greece, blue background with white (Greek) cross, opposite to those of Finland, *just as are the names too, As-Hel-Hel-As*. **The Bock, the**

God of Fertility, had red clothing with golden yellow belt, as are the colors of the Coat of arms (meaning the foreskin) of Finland, which is right in the center of the state-flag of Finland, meaning that he is inseminating his wife, and all other people too on earth. (later he will become the Lord, Ukko)

The names of the numerous islands and bays in front of Uden-land, as well as in the continent, tell that the "royal" family with all their activities, had lived here, during those tens (perhaps hundreds) of thousands of years. Many counterparts of their customs were transformed to other countries later on, with the people who moved there, just as this story of the Yule Bock too, to Greece, Near East, India, China, and Egypt.

Yule Bock and his family are as Finnish as can be, Finland is the only country where he comes inside people's houses at Yule evening, he is not seen even at other Scandinavian countries. Our Yule-tree itself and its decorations are telling actually their story. We have numerous stories about them.

Even Finland's independence was declared at 6th of December, which is the day of Nicolaus, the Yule Bock. Also Napoleon and Alexander the II, the Tsar of Russia, made the pact to divide Sweden at 07, 07, 07, the day of semen, of the Yule Bock, Finland was born then, Alexander become the Grand Duchy of Finland!

Welcome to Finland, to the country of the Yule Bock.
